















MORE THAN A GAME

BLOCK BOOKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

-  A block booking is only accepted in the name of the Club Secretary who holds a current Pro-Soccer Membership for their club / school / association.
-  The document constitutes a formal agreement between the club / school / association and Pro-Soccer Football Complex where all bookings are for the exclusive use of their club / school / association.
-  A block booking agreement is for a minimum of ELEVEN bookings (specified on the agreement) where the interval between each booking is at least 1 day but not more than 14 days. All reservations must be paid for whether taken up or not.
-  The block booking must be paid for in full, however, payment does not need to be made in advance, it can be paid in 11 instalments during the course of the booking providing each booking is paid in full prior to play.
-  The cost for the series of 11 bookings will be specified on the block booking agreement.
-  Should a price increase incur during the agreement, 14 days notice will be given with an option to discontinue given.
-  Accepted payment types are cash, cheque (with guarantee card) and most credit / debit cards.
-  Only one reservation may be cancelled per block. Seven days notice must be given to Pro-Soccer of this request.
-  Should any fees not be received, Pro-Soccer will invoice the Club Secretary for the total amount due, payable within 14 days.
-  Should the balance remain outstanding, Pro-Soccer Ltd reserve the right to have the total due collected by a solicitor/debt collector
-  Provision will be made by Pro-Soccer for a refund should a cancellation be made in the event of non-availability of our facility.
-  Members are advised that pitch hire fees charged for the use of our football pitches do not include insurance cover for on the pitch sporting injuries. You are advised to consider taking out 'Personal Injury' and 'Public Liability Insurance' when arranging or competing in 5-a-side and 7-a-side matches.
